original participants and the growing number of children born to Neo-Pagan families—is resulting in Neo-Paganism developing some of the marks of a mature and established religion.

Esto le será beneficioso si su bondad es devuelta a usted de esta manera por sus buenas obras, pero si tiene intenciones dañinas y negativas, las consecuencias también serán perjudiciales. Los wiccanos creen en los hechizos y esto es parte de respetar y honrar el mundo que nos rodea en lugar de "crear milagros". Debido a que lanzar un hechizo es una respuesta emocional, se requiere una apreciación de las energías que existen en el universo natural.
