When we think about the Victorian age, we usually envision people together with animals: the Queen and her pugs, the sportsman with horses and hounds, the big game hunter with his wild kill, the gentleman farmer with a prize bull. Harriet Ritvo here gives us a vivid picture of how animals figured in English thinking during the nineteenth century and, by extension, how they served as metaphors for human psychological needs and sociopolitical aspirations. Victorian England was a period of burgeoning scientific cattle breeding and newly fashionable dog shows; an age of Empire and big game hunting; an era of reform and reformers that saw the birth of the Royal SPCA. Ritvo examines Victorian thinking about animals in the context of other lines of thought: evolution, class structure, popular science and natural history, imperial domination. The papers and publications of people and organizations concerned with agricultural breeding, veterinary medicine, the world of pets, vivisection and other humane causes, zoos, hunting at home and abroad, all reveal underlying assumptions and deeply held convictions—for example, about Britain's imperial enterprise, social discipline, and the hierarchy of orders, in nature and in human society. Thus this book contributes a new new topic of inquiry to Victorian studies; its combination of rhetorical analysis with more conventional methods of historical research offers a novel perspective on Victorian culture. And because nineteenth-century attitudes and practices were often the ancestors of contemporary ones, this perspective can also inform modern debates about human-animal interactions.

This book describes five years of adventure experienced by one Forrest Fenn treasure hunter and his searcher friends. The preface provides a summary of how his ground search experiences were driven from complex to simplified "Moby Dick" solutions to the chase poem. This overview is followed by a detailed analysis of the hints and clues that supported his Moby Dick solution. While history will likely establish that Melville's Moby Dick was not a core element of the winning solve, this book narrative will hopefully provide insight to non-searchers about the sorts of intellectual and emotional rewards that were associated with this treasure hunt. This is a prototypic solve, and each step in building this compelling evidentiary base was personally rewarding. The author provides first-hand examples of the risks posed to searchers regarding confirmation biases and rabbit holes. Coincidences are inevitable in all detective searches for presumed fact associations. This story also describes the evolution of an unfit flatlander with no hunting or wildness experience into a seasoned amateur treasure hunter with a hundred miles of risk exposure. So while this solve may be viewed as Exhibit A for futile problem solving effort, the fun of crafting these hypotheses should not be understated. This book advances stories and ideas that should be of general interest to the chase community, specialized interest to behavioral scientists, and keen personal interest to citizens of Buffalo and Bighorn Mountain hikers. This book also includes references to many seasoned searchers who contributed enormously to the chase literature. It seems a certainty that success in this treasure hunt required indirect assistance from a great many talented searchers who graciously contributed to the chase literature.
