Volume one explored some of the most famous sites around Kathmandu. Now it's time to leave the capital and head into the hills. The aim of this book is to encourage and inform the everyday adventurer. You may identify with one or more of the following;> You haven't

been working out in the gym or carrying bags of sand in your backpack however you do enjoy a 2-5 hour day walk on the weekends.> You've never been rafting but you'd like to try it. > You don't mind roughing it a bit.> Perhaps you're just curious and want to learn more about Nepal. > You don't want to risk altitude sickness but you'd still love to do some trekking in Nepal.Keep in mind, we will always be well below the altitude sickness level. For some people, this can start as low as 2,500 meters (8,000 feet). Minor symptoms such as breathlessness may occur at altitudes of 1,500 meters (5,000 feet.) The highest altitude we'll be going is 1,750 meters (5,742 feet) at Namu Buddha. I have to admit to feeling a little breathless in chapter 4 (Lots of prayer flags: Namu

Buddha). Expect larger than usual inhalations when you walk up this hill.This book will give you many insights into some of the challenges you may face when trekking in Nepal. It's not intended for serious mountaineers. Nor is it for those wanting a 5-star resort experience. At the end of this volume, I share my pre-travel tips to help you plan your adventure.This book is not meant to give an all-inclusive guide to the places visited during this short 2 weeks holiday.After reading this book you'll have a much clearer idea about if this sort of adventure is for you. Above all I trust the photos and commentary in this book will inspire you to visit Nepal.I've divided the journey into 2 volumes. Each volume contains many quality original photographs. Volume 1 begins with a

solo exploration of the Monkey Temple (Swayambhunath), parts of the ancient city Patan, the Garden of Dreams and the Narayanhiti Palace Museum. There's a visit to the Seven Women Nepal enterprise and a day walk through the Shiva Puri Nagarjun National Park. Our travel group meets up to explore Nepal's largest Buddhist stupa and the famous cremation site Pashupatinath. While exploring Kathmandu's Durbar Square we met the famous living goddess, Kumari. Volume 2 leaves Kathmandu and heads to the ancient city of Bhaktapur. After exploring Bhaktapur we drive into the countryside. We walk to a small rural village named Balthali. After a restful night, we walk from Balthali to the sacred Buddhist pilgrimage site of Namobuddha. We travel into the

Nuwakot district to visit The Famous Farm and trek around the hills. There's an overnight camp out as we raft down the Trishuli River before heading back to Kathmandu to say our goodbyes.
