The Supreme Court (SC) of India in its verdict dated February 2, 2012 canceled 122 licenses granted on or after January 10, 2008 by the Minister of Communications and Information Technology (MoC&IT) Mr A Raja. This was in response to litigation filed during 2010 and 2011 by Centre for Public Interest Litigation (CPIL), Lok Satta, and Common Cause, all non-governmental organizations, and other eminent citizens. With respect to the cancelled licenses, the SC directed the Telecom Regulatory Authority of India (TRAI) to make recommendations for grant of license and allocation of spectrum by auction in 2G bands in 22 service areas and adopt the same approach as for the allocation of the 3G band. The petitions filed were related to the fairness of allocation of spectrum for 2G services in India, the role of the TRAI, the processes adopted by the Department of Telecommunications (DoT) for spectrum allocations, and grant of licenses to ineligible applicants.
