The purpose of completing the questionnaire is to determine the likelihood that a particular person will attempt suicide.What Is the Beck Hopelessness Scale? (with pictures)The Beck Hopelessness Scale questionnaire consists of twenty

true/false questions examining the respondent's attitude for the past week, such as: I might as well give up because there's nothing I can do to make things better for me I happen to be particularly lucky and I expect to get more of the good things in life than the average person

Beck Hopelessness Scale (BHS)

The Beck Hopelessness Scale is a self-report measure for adults age 17 to 80. It assesses an individual's negative expectations about the future. The measure includes 20 items to which participants respond with "true" or "false."

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Beck Hopelessness Scale ® (BHS ®)

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The Beck's Hopelessness Scale (BHS) was developed within the context of research on suicidal behaviour and depression [2, 8, 9]. It is a widely used instrument and has undergone numerous validation studies. A Chinese version has also been developed by Shek [10]. Useful though the BHS is, the length of 20 items is a discouraging factor.
