 In 1806 a British privateer limped into the Tongan archipelago. This is the story of the fifteen year-old ship's clerk who, in four years, rose from being a naked and derided castaway to a member of the Tongan aristocracy. Surviving a massacre aboard the ship, Mariner was adopted by its perpetrator, King Finau, and groomed to be his lieutenant. Mariner's graphic account of the impact of western arms upon a stone-age population is matched by his descriptions of the chaotic scenes that followed as Finau's army

resorted to cannibalism and headhunting. But by placing himself at the centre of the action and airbrushing out the other crewmembers Mariner constructed a gripping but deeply deceptive narrative.
