Discuss wellness plans, including the pros and cons of insurance and/or other forms of healthcare financial planning to help pet owners comply with an optimal wellness plan. Staging of procedures, multiple visits, and various payment options may help increase compliance and ensure that patients receive as many of the wellness recommendations as possible.
