I wanted to compute 80th term of the Fibonacci series. I wrote the rampant recursive function, `int fib(int n){ return (1==n || 2==n) ? 1 : fib(n-1) + fib(n-2); }` and waited for the result. I wait... and wait... and wait... With an 8GB RAM and an Intel i5 CPU, why is it taking so long? I terminated the process and tried computing the 40th term. It took about a second.
