Learning from the World Lonely Planet

The Marquess of Queensberry is as famous for his role in the downfall of one of our greatest literary geniuses as he was for helping establish the rules for modern-day boxing. The trial and two-year imprisonment of Oscar Wilde, lover of Queensberry's son, Lord Alfred Douglas, remains one of literary history's great tragedies. However, Linda Stratmann's riveting biography of the Marquess paints a far more complex picture by drawing on new sources and unpublished letters. Throughout his life, Queensberry was emotionally damaged by a series of tragedies, and the events of the Wilde affair "told for the first time from the Marquess's perspective" were directly linked to Queensberry's personal crises. Through the retelling of pivotal events from Queensberry's life—the death of his brother on the Matterhorn and his fruitless search for the body; the suicides of his father, brother, and eldest son—the book reveals a well-meaning man often stricken with a grief he found hard to express, who deserves our compassion.

Am 14. Juli 1865 steht der fünfundzwanzigjährige Engländer Edward Whymper als erster Mensch auf dem Matterhorn, aber beim Abstieg stürzen vier seiner Begleiter in den Tod: ein Seil ist gerissen. Wenige Tage nach Whymper's Aufstieg von Zermatt aus erreicht der einheimische Bergführer Jean-Antoine Carrel von der italienischen Seite aus den Gipfel. Er ist der eigentliche Held in Reinhold Messners atemberaubender Geschichte von der Eroberung eines unverwechselbaren Berges, vermutlich der erste Mensch, der eine Besteigung des Matterhorns für möglich hielt. Carrel ist das Gegenbild zu dem dandyhaften Whymper: wortkarg, instinktiv und voller Verantwortung für seine Männer bis in die Stunde des eigenen Todes - fünfundzwanzig Jahre später, am Matterhorn. Das Matterhorn ist auch heute noch ein Mythos. Im Jahr 1865 war es der letzte noch unerstiegene große Alpengipfel, einer der letzten weißen Flecken auf der Landkarte - mitten in Europa. Warum bei Edward Whymper's Erstbesteigung das Seil reißt, ist eine Frage, die damals halb Europa bewegt hat. Die Frage, wer dafür verantwortlich ist, lässt Reinhold Messner auch heute noch nicht los. In seiner fesselnden Erzählung von Verantwortung, Vertrauen und Verrat wird er Teil der Seilschaft von 1865: »Ich will nochmals mit den Bergsteigern hinaufsteigen. Ich will nachempfinden, was sie getragen hat - und was sie ertragen mussten.«
