O Alouatta belzebul, um primata conhecido como bugio, possui uma ampla distribuição geográfica. Os animais desta espécie são de comportamento discreto, com movimentos lentos, têm sua dieta fundamentalmente folívora. O presente estudo tem por finalidade descrever a anatomia macroscópica da coxa e perna de A. belzebul, como a origem e inserção muscular, irrigação e inervação de suas estruturas. Após dissecação, observou-se que os ossos como acidente anatômico têm sua similaridade com o humano, assim, os músculos da coxa e perna do A. belzebul são: tensor da fásia lata, sartório, vasto lateral, vasto medial, vasto intermédio, adutor longo, adutor curto, pectíneo, grácil, bíceps femoral, semitendinoso, semimembranoso, supridos pela artéria femoral e nervo isquiático e suas ramificações, gastrocnêmio, sóleo, poplíteo, tibial posterior, tibial anterior, flexor longo dos dedos, flexor longo do hálux, fibular longo e curto, extensor acessório, extensor longo dos dedos, extensor longo do hálux. Semelhantes às observações feitas no A. belzebul, encontramos a similaridade na descrição com os humanos e em demais primatas não humanos, como Sapajus libidinosus, chimpanzés e babuínos, supostamente por ambos serem quadrúpedes, apresentarem comportamento semibípede e arborícola.
