The cities of Cape Town, Christchurch, Hobart, Punta Arenas, and Ushuaia are formally recognized international gateway cities through which flows most travel to the Antarctic region. roles and responsibilities of these five cities formally recognized as the Antarctic gateway cities. It has sought to summarize this change in conception and function by interchanging 'gateway' with 'custodian'. In this context, it seeks to inform decision-makers and citizens on how their Antarctic gateway cities can best effect a cultural, political, ecological, and economic transition towards becoming Antarctic custodial cities.
