 Vincent Donovan is best known as the author of the influential bestseller, *Christianity Rediscovered* (1978). This new book contains the monthly letters he wrote home from Tanzania between 1957 and 1973. These letters give us previously unknown stories: how Donovan met Julius Nyerere, first prime minister of Tanzania; how a group of Protestants
