Victimae Paschali Laudes Linksma Diena Mums Prasvito Carillon bells once were only heard by people outside the church, while only chimes were sometimes heard playing with the organ. Today carillon bells can be heard inside the church as well, some due to using microphones in the steeple carrying the sound to speakers in the church, but more commonly today through digital bell carillon systems that may also play from the organ and be heard in the church. This series of playable arrangements of hymn tunes are written to expand the scope of music for organ playing with carillon, chimes and organ handbell stops. With the richer sound of carillon bells and handbells, the series includes pieces that are composed to as Preludes but also as Postludes. By keeping with the standard keys of these hymns, they are useful when introducing hymns that are already well-known by the congregation, adding a new dimension to the church service. Handbell parts are included, very useful for a beginning choir, and also as a quick substitute when ringers are absent - no reason to announce the bells won't be playing if you have prepared a few of these as backup pieces. They may be

played by a small number of ringers or even a solo ringer. A solo ringer may play these with an organist to create interest in a church interested in restarting a handbell program or start one with a new set of bells. The music is written out on two staves. Pedals are optional for the organist. Pedals may also be played using a Bass coupler. Composer Noel Jones is an Associate of the American Guild of Organists and worked as church musician in the United States and Europe. He was organist for the Church Center for the United Nations and accompanied the United Nations Singers in concert. Frog Music Press has published collections of playable hymns in three parts for organists as well as a Guide to Hymnplaying for Organists. Contained within is a piece each for Ash Wednesday, Palm Sunday, Maundy Thursday, Good Friday, and three pieces for Eastertide. From the quiet introspection of the Lenten selections to the brilliant rhythms and colors of the Easter pieces, these works are sure to become favorites. Many of the chosen hymns are also useful in other seasons, providing extra versatility.

The sixteen pieces of *Officium Divinum* are made up of four choral pieces with organ, two a cappella pieces and ten choral pieces with organ and instrumental accompaniment. They follow the journey of Daily Prayer from awakening at the break of the day to the eyelids closing at the end of the day. Margaret says: "Chants are so easy to perform and also lovely to sing and to work at. Through the repetitions, a chant starts in the head with all its thinking and begins the long journey into the heart. There one begins to be open to the beauty of prayer, and drawn into deeper levels of reflection and stillness. Singing chants is a wonderful way to share, as we come to pray together." The music has also been recorded by Convivium Singers, conducted by Eamonn Dougan, and is available as a CD.

Glory in the Cross Augsburg Fortress Pub

In this volume, Peter Niedmann presents imaginative arrangements of hymns that are useful during Lent, Holy Week, and Eastertide. The Lenten hymns receive generally introverted, quiet settings, while the Easter hymns burst with joy. Niedmann's rich, distinctive harmonic language makes for striking and powerful pieces for these most important seasons.
