This volume addresses an important historiographical gap by assessing the respective contributions of tradition and foreign influences to the 19th century codification of criminal law. More specifically, it focuses on the extent of French influence – among others – in European and American civil law jurisdictions. In this regard, the book seeks to dispel a number of myths concerning

the French model’s actual influence on European and Latin American criminal codes. The impact of the Napoleonic criminal code on other jurisdictions was real, but the scope and extent of its influence were significantly less than has sometimes been claimed. The overemphasis on French influence on other civil law jurisdictions is partly due to a fundamental assumption that modern criminal codes constituted a break with the past. The question as to whether they truly broke with the past or were merely a degree of reform touches on a difficult issue, namely, the dichotomy between tradition and foreign influences in the codification of criminal law. Scholarship has unfairly ignored this important subject, an oversight that this book remedies.

Le lezioni di Hegel sulla storia della filosofia costituiscono il laboratorio concettuale e terminologico del suo sistema di

pensiero e delineano lo svolgimento storico che ad esso ha condotto. Tuttavia Hegel non ha mai dato alle stampe i testi dei suoi corsi, di cui resta traccia solo grazie a manoscritti, quaderni, appunti e annotazioni, autografe o dovute agli uditori. La sola traduzione italiana delle lezioni sulla storia della filosofia fino a oggi disponibile riproduceva l'edizione del 1840-44, curata da Karl Ludwig Michelet dopo la morte di Hegel. In linea con la più recente ricerca, a quel testo si è qui preferita l'edizione del corso berlinese del 1825-1826 pubblicata in Germania tra il 1986 e il 1996, a cura di Pierre Garniron e Walter Jaeschke. Il volume è corredato di un apparato di note e di un'introduzione a firma del curatore Roberto Bordoli. In appendice è data la traduzione dei manoscritti hegeliani relativi alle introduzioni ai corsi del 1820 e del 1823.

The following bibliography, arranged chronologically, permits the reader to follow the development of phenomenological studies in Italy in parallel with other, contemporary, cultural currents. From this list it can be seen that knowledge of Husserl's work begins in 1923 with the studies of A. Banfi. Phenomenology, however, did not immediately receive a warm welcome. It contrasted with the then dominant neo-idealism (as has been made clear by G. De Ruggiero), but for this very reason it also found adherents among the opponents of idealism. These were either distant heirs of positivism, who accepted Husserl on account of his scientific approach and rigor, or Christian oriented thinkers, who, following an initial period of diffidence toward the antimetaphysical attitude of phenomenological analysis, gradually began to use this method as an antiidealist instrument - even though the

problem remained of Husserl's own transcendental idealism and the value to be attributed to it. Despite the difficulties encountered on the way, the numerous studies carried out in Italy prior to World War II make it clear that the better known philosophers who have left a mark on Italian culture already had begun to take a discreet interest in phenomenology.

Vita e Pensiero  
Licitas usura, vale a dire liceità del prestito ad interesse, è un concetto non soltanto legittimato dai codici emanati in epoca moderna, ma talmente inciso nella coscienza comune da costituire il perno fondamentale attorno al quale mostra di continuare a ruotare l'universale realtà economica e sociale. Ancora oggi continuano ad affiorare perplessità, se non profondi dubbi, sulla validità o, quanto meno, sui limiti d'applicabilità di sistemi integralmente basati sulla diffusione generalizzata delle pratiche feneratorie. Nella realtà contemporanea, sebbene in termini totalmente differenti, paiono rivivere le medesime rationes, d'ordine etico e giuridico, su cui si fondavano quanti si pronunciarono pro vel contra la licitas del prestito ad interessi dall'epoca medievale sino alla prima metà del XIX secolo. La fedele riproposizione delle opinioni espresse da tali autori e, di conseguenza, la ricostruzione delle modalità di svolgimento dell'intera disputa, costituisce l'obiettivo di questo lavoro. Sono qui presi in considerazione solamente quanti, fra teologi, canonisti e legisti, mostrarono d'aver acquisito un'auctoritas indiscussa ovvero d'aver manifestato peculiari originalità nei modi d'argomentare le proprie opinioni oppure, ancora, d'aver messo in luce maggior vivacità polemica nel contestare le tesi dei

loro adversarii. Un mosaico, quindi, indubbiamente mancante di molti tasselli, ma in grado, per la lucentezza delle “immagini”, di rendere in qualche modo visibile il tortuoso iter percorso dalla disputa nel suo lunghissimo esplicitarsi.

Das Buch untersucht nullum crimen sine lege als europäischen Grundsatz. Die Untersuchung konzentriert sich auf die Rolle der Vorhersehbarkeit als Lösung für die Legalitätsprobleme, die sich aus dem Richterrecht im Strafrecht ergeben. Die Vorhersehbarkeit und seine Entwicklung werden in der Rechtsprechung des EGMR untersucht. Aktuelle Lösungen, die von Zivilrechtsstaaten (Italien und Deutschland) angenommen wurden, werden auch unter Berücksichtigung der theoretischen Grundlagen von ncs1 analysiert. Darüber hinaus wird die Rolle der Vorhersehbarkeit im EU-Recht als Beispiel für eine wirkungsorientierte Rechtsordnung betrachtet. Abschließend werden Zukunftsperspektiven für die Umsetzung der Vorhersehbarkeit analysiert.

Despite the fact that it seems to represent an issue directly connected with the question of where legal history is heading today, it still has not been the object of a focused inquiry. Against this background, the book's proposal consists in rethinking key confluences related to this problem in order to provide coordinates for a collective understanding and dialogue. The aim of this volume, however, is

not to offer abstract methodological considerations, but rather to rely both on concrete studies, out of which a reflection on this conjunction emerges, as well as on the reconstruction of certain research lines featuring a spatiotemporal component. This analytical approach makes a contribution by providing some suggestions for the employment of space and time as coordinates for legal history. Indeed, contrary to those historiographical attitudes reflecting a monistic conception of space and time (as well as a Eurocentric approach), the book emphasises the need for a delocalized global perspective. In general terms, the essays collected in this book intend to take into account the multiplicity of the spatiotemporal confines, the flexibility of those instruments that serve to create chronologies and scenarios, as well as certain processes of adaptation of law to different times and into different spaces. The spatiotemporal dynamism enables historians not only to detect new perspectives and dimensions in foregone themes, but also to achieve new and compelling interpretations of legal history. As far as the relationship between space and law is concerned, the book analyses experiences in which space operates as a determining factor of law, e.g. in terms of a field of action for law. Moreover, it outlines the attempted scales of spatiality in order to develop legal historical research. With reference to the connection between time and law, the volume sketches the possibility of considering the factor of time, not just as a descriptive tool, but as an ascriptive moment (quasi an inner feature) of a legal problem, thus making it possible to appreciate the synchronic aspects of the 'juridical experience'. As a whole, the volume aims to present spatiotemporality as a challenge for legal history.

Indeed, reassessing the value of the spatiotemporal coordinates for legal history implies thinking through both the thematic and methodological boundaries of the discipline."
