Jewish folk music influenced me the most. I can't stop admire it. It is so versatile. It may seem happy, and in fact be deeply tragic ... Each real folk music is beautiful, but Jewish - one of a kind. "

The authors seek to recover some unjustly forgotten, but endlessly expressive melodies. They wish these songs can help people be happy and always have humoristic and optimistic attitude towards life!
