 Major issues and problems facing public school superintendents were defined through an analysis of conferences and personal interviews with 47 administrators of various-sized districts in 22 states. Assisting the research team were personnel from 11 state departments of education, six regional educational laboratories, 36 colleges and universities, and the USOE. Findings of the study indicate that public school superintendents are apprehensive and

concerned. Many feel their training was inadequate for the conditions under which they now work and question the value of the few in-service training programs available to them.
